CONTINUATION ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition under section 14/15(3)(a) of NCTE Act, 1993 was granted to the institution namely **Kalkadham Snatkottar Mahavidyalaya, Post – Sewapuri, District – Varanasi-221403, Uttar Pradesh** for conducting **B.P.Ed.** Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 50 vide order No. NRC/NCTE/F-7/6080-6091 dated 19.09.2006.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, after promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has not consented to come under the Regulations 2014 and affidavit in this regard was also not submitted by the institution. Hence, revised recognition order for B.P.Ed. two year duration was not issued to the institution.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before NRC in its 325th Meeting held on 08th to 09th January, 2021 and the Committee decided as under :-

“ Consideration of the matter of Revised Recognition Orders(RRO)

Regional Director placed before the Committee, a list of 362 such institutions to whom RRO has not been issued till today due to not submission of required affidavit stating that institution will be comply with the conditions prescribed under Regulations, 2014, for consideration and decision of Committee.

The Committee discussed the matter in depth and decided to issue Show Cause Notice under Section 17 to institutions as per List put up before Committee for not making compliance to Regulations, 2014. ”

Accordingly, Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 was issued to the institution vide letter No. F.NRC/NCTE/ (Item No. 107/Minutes of the 325th (Virtual) Meeting/2020/210876-211237 dated 19.01.2021.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted reply of Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, received in NRC office on 29.01.2021. The matter was placed before NRC in its 404th (Blended mode) Meeting held on 18th July, 2023 and the Committee decided Final Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 following grounds :-

“The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC and the Committee observed following:

The recognition was granted to the institution for B.P.Ed. course of one year duration vide order dated 19/09/2006.



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3. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was placed before NRC in its 325th Meeting held on 08th to 09th January, 2021 and the Committee decided as under :-

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Regional Director placed before the Committee, a list of 362 such institutions to whom RRO has not been issued till today due to not submission of required affidavit stating that institution will be comply with the conditions prescribed under Regulations, 2014, for consideration and decision of Committee.

The Committee discussed the matter in depth and decided to issue Show Cause Notice under Section 17 to institutions as per List put up before Committee for not making compliance to Regulations, 2014. "

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted reply of Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, received in NRC office on 29.01.2021. The matter was placed before NRC in its 404th (Blended mode) Meeting held on 18th July, 2023 and the Committee decided Final Show Cause Notice under section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 following grounds :-

"The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC and the Committee observed following:

The recognition was granted to the institution for B.P.Ed. course of one year duration vide order dated 19/09/2006.



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After promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution has not consented to come under the Regulations 2014 and affidavit in this regard was also not submitted by the institution. Hence, revised recognition order for B.P.Ed. two year duration was not issued to the institution.

As per decision of NRC in its 325th Meeting held on 8th to 9th January 2021 first SCN was issued to the institution on 19/01/2021, on the following grounds:

- Whether the institution has submitted affidavit to NRC for issuance of Revised Recognition order. If yes, please submit proof of the same and if not, then furnish reasons of non-submission of the affidavit to NRC.
- The institution has to submit whether they had submitted compliance with the conditions prescribed under Regulations, 2014 (Enhanced FDRs, Revised staff profile, additional built up area etc) for consideration and decision of the Committee without issuance of revised recognition order and after submission of affidavit from the list attached.
- If the institution does not fall in any of above two categories, then institution is required to inform NRC about their status in respect of revised recognition order compliance matters.

The institution has submitted reply of first SCN vide letter dated 29/01/2021. The committee considered the reply dated 29/01/2021 and observed the following:

- The institution is required to submit proof / evidence to prove that it is a Multi-disciplinary institution as per clause 2(b) of NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution is required to submit Certified registered land documents issued by the Registering Authority
- The institution is required to submit Blue print of approved Building plan signed by the Competent Govt. Authority indicating the name of the course, name of the institution, Khasra No./Plot No., total land area, total built-up area with the measurements of the Multi-purpose Hall as well other infrastructural facilities such as class rooms etc.
- The institution is required to submit Land Use Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority to use the land for educational purpose.
- The institution is required to submit Non-Encumbrance Certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority indicating that the land is free from all encumbrances.
- The institution is required to submit Certified copy of site plan with demarcated land area for running different courses.
- The institution is required to submit Building safety certificate from the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Certificate to the effect that the building is differently abled friendly from the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit Building Completion Certificate signed by the Competent Government Authority.
- The institution is required to submit latest/current faculty list approved & signed each page by concerned affiliating body in original with the details of their teaching subject, date of birth, date of selection, date of joining, academic qualifications, teaching experience, NET/Ph.D. (NCTE's GOI dated 09.06.2017), salary structure

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- and related documents duly attested by authorized management representative not submitted. And, notarized original affidavit of Rs. 100/- on non-judicial stamp paper by the management and Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper by each selected/appointed faculty in the NCTE prescribed proforma.
- The institution is required to submit details of salary disbursed to the faculty along with six months Bank statement and account number of each faculty members.
- The institution is required to submit copies of valid Fixed Deposit Receipts Nationalized/ Scheduled Bank towards Endowment & Reserve Fund in the joint operation mode with RD, NRC, NCTE & Management along with duly field Bank Form "A" in original, verified/signed by the Manager of the Bank as per NCTE Regulations, 2014.
- The institution is required to submit downloaded copies of documents from the website of the institution with hyperlinks of the same as per provisions of 7(14) of the NCTE Regulations, 2014.

Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice Under Section 17 of the NCTE Act, 1993 be issued to the institution on 26.07.2023.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution has submitted reply dated 14.08.2023 Final Show Cause Notice Under Section 17 of NCTE Act, 1993. The matter was considered by NRC in its 408th (Blended Mode) meeting held on 16th & 17th August, 2023 and the committee decided as under:

" The original file of the institution along with other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time were carefully considered by NRC and the Committee observed following:

As per decision of NRC in its 404th meeting Final SCN was issued to the institution on 26/07/2023. The institution has submitted reply of final SCN vide letter dated 14/08/2023. The NRC considered the reply dated 14/08/2023 and observed the following:

- The institution has submitted all required documents against the Final SCN.

In view of the above, the NRC decided that recognition continuation order for B.P.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual basic units of 100 (one hundred) students with two sections of 50 (fifty) each be issued to the institution.

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. Kalkadham Snatkottar Mahavidyalaya, Post - Sewapuri, District - Varanasi-221403, Uttar Pradesh for continuation of recognition for B.P.Ed. Course Programme for two-years duration with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students with two sections of 50 (fifty) each subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- (i) The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- (ii) The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.



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(iii) The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

(iv) The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

7. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc. as applicable.

8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self - Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

9. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Northern Regional Committee, covering, inter - alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- (a) Sanctioned programme(s) along with annual intake in the institution;
 - (b) Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - (c) Name of faculty members who left of joined during the last, quarter;
 - (d) Name of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - (e) Fee charged from students;
 - (f) Available infrastructural facilities;
 - (g) Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - (h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - (i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - (j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information if it so desires.
 - (k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
10. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
11. The institution shall make available the list of students admitted on its official website.
12. The institution shall fill the information on GIS Portal on the NCTE Website.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made of issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Northern Regional Committee under the provisional of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.



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
